Summary (as of Sep 11, 2008)

Secure Education for Americans Today Act of 2008 or the SEAT Act of 2008 - Prohibits the provision of federal funds to institutions of higher education that admit illegal aliens.

Prohibits such provision from being construed as denying federal student assistance to students attending such schools.
