Summary (as of Sep 23, 2008)

National Commission on American Cybersecurity Act of 2008 - Establishes the National Commission on American Cybersecurity to analyze the cybersecurity of American business, national infrastructure, and U.S. Government non-military and non-national security related computer systems and to recommend a comprehensive cybersecurity strategy for those systems.

Actions Timeline

- Sep 23, 2008: Introduced in House
- Sep 23, 2008: Referred to the Committee on Science and Technology, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- Sep 23, 2008: Referred to the Subcommittee on Technology and Innovation.
