Summary (as of Sep 25, 2008)

America's Right-to-Eat Rescue Act of 2008 - Applies, for a specified six-month period, the poverty line used in making eligibility determinations under the Food Stamp and School Lunch programs in Alaska to the same eligibility determinations in all states and the District of Columbia.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 19, 2008:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Department Operations, Oversight, Nutrition and Forestry.
- **Sep 25, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 25, 2008:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
