Summary (as of Dec 17, 2007)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration of the following Senate amendments on the same day they are presented to the House: (1) the Senate amendment to H.R. 2764 (Department of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2008); and (2) the Senate amendments to H.R. 6 (Renewable Fuels, Consumer Protection, and Energy Efficiency Act of 2007).

- **Dec 17, 2007:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H15508-15512)
- **Dec 17, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 873.
- **Dec 17, 2007:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 873, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Lincoln Diaz-Balart demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Dec 17, 2007:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H15514-15516)
- **Dec 17, 2007:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 215 - 183 (Roll no. 1165). (consideration: CR H15512, H15514-15515)
