### **Summary** (as of Feb 6, 2008)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendars and Committee Reports) to allow consideration on the same day it is presented to the House of any resolution reported on the legislative day of Thursday, February 7, 2008, relating to a bill to provide economic stimulus.

#### **Actions Timeline**

- Feb 26, 2008: Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 974, H. Res. 955 is laid on the table.
- Feb 6, 2008: Introduced in House
- Feb 6, 2008: The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-522, by Ms. Slaughter.
- Feb 6, 2008: The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The rule applies the waiver to any resolution reported on the legislative day of Thursday, February 7, 2008, relating to a bill to provide economic stimulus.
- Feb 6, 2008: Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 184.
