- **Feb 13, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR 2/12/2009 H1263)
- **Feb 13, 2009:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR 2/12/2009 H1263)
- **Feb 13, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Feb 12, 2009:** Mr. Lynch moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Feb 12, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1263-1267)
- **Feb 12, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 110.
