Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 3961) to amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to reform the Medicare SGR payment system for physicians and to reinstitute and update the Pay-As-You-Go requirement of budget neutrality on new tax and mandatory spending legislation, enforced by the threat of annual, automatic sequestration.

## Actions Timeline

- **Feb 25, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 25, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-420, by Mr. Perlmutter.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** The resolution provides for the consideration of the Senate amendments to H.R. 3961. The resolution makes in order a single motion by the Chair of the Committee on the Judiciary to concur in the Senate amendments. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the motion except clause 10 of Rule XXI and provides that the Senate amendments shall be considered as read. Finally, the resolution provides one hour of debate on the motion equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 164.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** Mr. Perlmutter moved that the House now consider the resolution.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** On motion that the House now consider the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H845-848)
- **Feb 25, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1109.
- **Feb 25, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H848)
- **Feb 25, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H845)
- **Feb 25, 2010:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H845)
- **Feb 25, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
