Summary

Long Term Care Quality Improvement Act of 2009 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to require skilled nursing facilities to separately report expenditures for wages and benefits for nursing staff (by staff level, breaking out (at a minimum) registered nurses, licensed professional nurses, and certified nurse assistants).

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 24, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Referred to House Ways and Means
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Referred to House Energy and Commerce
