- **Mar 9, 2010:** Introduced in House

- **Mar 9, 2010:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Con. Res. 248 with 3 hours of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
