Summary (as of Feb 24, 2009)

CSRS Retirement Repayment Technical Correction Act of 2009 - Exempts repayments of Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) refunds made between October 1, 1990, and February 28, 1991, from the requirement that they include interest in order to receive retirement credit for the service covered.

Makes such exemption effective as if included in the enactment of the Omnibus Budget and Reconciliation Act of 1990.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 24, 2009:** Referred to House Oversight and Government Reform
- **Feb 24, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on House Administration, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
