- **Mar 11, 2010:** Introduced in House

- **Mar 11, 2010:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in part A of House Report 111-439 shall be considered as adopted.
