Summary (as of Mar 24, 2010)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 1586) to impose an additional tax on bonuses received from certain TARP recipients.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 25, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H2325-2330)
- **Mar 25, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1212.
- **Mar 25, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H2330)
- **Mar 25, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1212, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mrs. Slaughter demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Mar 25, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H2331-2332)
- **Mar 25, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 231 - 190 (Roll no. 188).(text: CR H2325)
- **Mar 25, 2010:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 231 - 190 (Roll no. 188). (text: CR H2325)
- **Mar 25, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Mar 24, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 24, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-456, by Ms. Slaughter.
- **Mar 24, 2010:** The resolution provides for consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill with an amendment debatable for one hour. The resolution also provides for the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules. In addition, the requirement waives the requirement for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Committee on Rules on the same day it is reported.
- **Mar 24, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 181.
