(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Commemorates the 40th anniversary of the Kent State University shootings that occurred on May 4, 1970, by: (1) recognizing the tragedy of the shootings and the implications that the shootings have had not only on Kent State and the local community, but also on the nation and the world; and (2) applauding the development of the May 4 visitors' center as an additional primary resource to preserve and communicate the history of the shootings, its larger ethical and societal context and impact, and its enduring meaning for our democratic nation.

Actions Timeline

- **May 5, 2010:** Ms. Chu moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **May 5, 2010:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H3144-3145)
- **May 5, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1272.
- **May 5, 2010:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
- **May 5, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3166, H3167)
- **May 5, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 415 - 0, 2 Present (Roll no. 247). (text: CR H3144)
