### Summary (as of May 25, 2010)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration or disposition of the Senate amendment to H.R. 4213 (amending the Internal Revenue Code to extend certain expiring provisions) on the same day it is presented to the House.

Makes it in order at any time through the calendar day of May 30, 2010, for the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules.

## Actions Timeline

---

- **May 28, 2010:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 1403, H. Res. 1392 is laid on the table.
- **May 25, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-494, by Mr. Hastings (FL).
- **May 25, 2010:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The resolution authorizes the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules at any time through the calendar day of May 30, 2010.
- **May 25, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 198.
