111 SRES 537	Related bill	May 26, 2010: Resolution agreed to in Senate without amendment and with a preamble by Unanimous Consent. (text: CR S4470)

Summary (as of May 27, 2010)

Expresses support for: (1) the designation of National Brain Tumor Awareness Month; (2) research to develop improved treatment options resulting in increased life spans for those with brain tumors; and (3) those who are battling brain tumors and their families, friends, and caregivers.

Encourages increased public awareness of brain tumors to honor individuals who are living with or who have lost their lives to brain tumors.

Urges a collaborative public-private approach to brain tumor research.
