Sets forth the rule for consideration of the conference report to accompany the bill (H.R. 4173) to provide for financial regulatory reform, to protect consumers and investors, to enhance Federal understanding of insurance issues, to regulate the over-the-counter derivatives markets.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 30, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 30, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-518, by Mr. Perlmutter.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** All points of order against the conference report and against its consideration are waived.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 208.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H5223-5231)
- **Jun 30, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1490.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H5231)
- **Jun 30, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1490, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Sessions demanded the yeas and nays, and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H5232)
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 234 - 189 (Roll no. 410).(text: CR H5223)
