Summary (as of Jun 30, 2010)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration of any resolution reported from the Committee on Rules through the legislative day of July 3, 2010, on the same day it is presented to the House.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 14, 2010:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 1509, H. Res. 1496 is laid on the table.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 30, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-520, by Mr. Cardoza.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The rule applies the waiver to any resolution reported through the legislative day of July 3, 2010.
- **Jun 30, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 210.
