- **Dec 15, 2009:** Mr. Conyers moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Dec 15, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H14894-14896)
- **Dec 15, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 150.
- **Dec 15, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Conyers objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
- **Dec 15, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H14943-14944)
- **Dec 15, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote (2/3 required): 395 - 23 (Roll no. 976).(text: CR H14894)
- **Dec 15, 2009:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote (2/3 required): 395 - 23 (Roll no. 976). (text: CR H14894)
- **Dec 15, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
