Recognizes the close relationship between the United States and the Republic of Georgia.

Remembers the victims of the August 2008 military conflict between Georgia and the Russian Federation.

Reaffirms support for a peaceful future for the region and for the unification of Georgia.

Supports the implementation of the United States-Georgia Strategic Partnership and the continued growth of bilateral relations.

Encourages Georgia to expand media freedoms, increase government transparency, promote democratic electoral processes, strengthen the rule of law, and implement judicial reforms.
