Sets forth the rule for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 301) directing the President, pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolution, to remove the United States Armed Forces from Pakistan.

- **Jul 27, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - The Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Dreier demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until later in the legislative day.
- **Jul 27, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H6112)
- **Jul 27, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 222 - 196 (Roll no. 470).(text: CR H6106)
