Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration or disposition of any measure related to H.R. 1 (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009).

- **Feb 25, 2009:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 184, H. Res. 158 is laid on the table.
- **Feb 11, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 11, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-15, by Ms. Slaughter.
- **Feb 11, 2009:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The resolution applies the waiver to any resolution reported through the legislative day of February 13, 2009, providing for consideration or disposition of any measure relating to H.R. 1, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
- **Feb 11, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 10.
