(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Recognizes the fifth anniversary of the congressional declaration of genocide in Darfur, Sudan.

Expresses regret that such determination has not yielded effective action on the part of the United Nations and other nations which maintain significant influence in Sudan, including China and certain Arab League members.

Urges: (1) the United States to work with other nations to support a negotiated settlement to the conflict; (2) U.N. member states to provide sufficient resources to support a fully capacitated African Union/United Nations Mission in Darfur (UNAMID); and (3) the parties to the conflict in Darfur to cease attacks upon civilians and humanitarian and peacekeeping operations and to commit to finding a political solution in Darfur.

- **Jul 29, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H9038)
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR 7/28/2009 H8946)
- **Jul 29, 2009:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR 7/28/2009 H8946)
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 28, 2009:** Mr. Faleomavaega moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Jul 28, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H8946-8948)
- **Jul 28, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 159.
- **Jul 28, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Ms. Ros-Lehtinen objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.

- **Jun 25, 2009:** Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs.
