Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendment to the House amendment to the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 1586) to modernize the air traffic control system, improve the safety, reliability, and availability of transportation by air in the United States, provide for modernization of the air traffic control system, reauthorize the Federal Aviation Administration.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 10, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1606, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Dreier demanded the Yeas and Nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 1606 until a time to be announced.

- **Aug 10, 2010:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 244 - 164 (Roll no. 516). (consideration: CR H6597, H6603)

- **Aug 10, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 229 - 173 (Roll no. 517).(text: CR H6590)
- **Aug 10, 2010:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 229 - 173 (Roll no. 517). (text: CR H6590)
- **Aug 10, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Aug 9, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 9, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-584, by Ms. Slaughter.
- **Aug 9, 2010:** It shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill H.R. 1586 and to consider in the House, without intervention of any point of order, a motion offered by the Chair of the Committee on Appropriations or his designee that the House concur in the Senate amendment to the House amendment to the Senate amendment to the bill. The Senate amendment and the motion shall be considered as read and the motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the motion to final adoption.
- **Aug 9, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 231.
