Encourages all students to set ambitious goals and work hard to achieve their dreams.

- **Nov 30, 2010:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Roe (TN) objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
