Summary (as of Sep 14, 2009)

Requires that an appointee to the position of Chief of the Army Medical Specialist Corps be of a rank not less than lieutenant colonel. (Current minimum rank is captain.)

Requires an appointee to such position holding a lower grade to be appointed in the regular grade of major general.
