Condemns the terrorist attacks on innocent Iraqi civilians.

Urges the government of Iraq to increase support for its displaced citizens within and outside of Iraq.

Encourages the government of Iraq to continue to develop its oil and gas resources, including implementation of the Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (EITI) and other measures to ensure the transparent functioning of the oil and gas sector.
