Summary (as of Dec 7, 2010)

Waives specified requirements of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration of resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules through the legislative day of December 18, 2010, on the same day they are presented to the House.

Makes it in order at any time through such date for the Speaker of the House to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 8, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H8110-8111)
- **Dec 8, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1752.
- **Dec 8, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H8111)
- **Dec 8, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - The Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Lincoln Diaz-Balart demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption of the resolution until a time to be announced.
- **Dec 8, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H8144-8145)
- **Dec 8, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 215 - 194 (Roll no. 615).(text: CR H8110)
- **Dec 8, 2010:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 215 - 194 (Roll no. 615). (text: CR H8110)
- **Dec 8, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Dec 7, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 7, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-674, by Mr. Polis (CO).
- **Dec 7, 2010:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The resolution also authorizes the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules at any time through the legislative day of December 18, 2010.
- **Dec 7, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 250.
