Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2965) to amend the Small Business Act with respect to the Small Business Innovation Research Program and the Small Business Technology Transfer Program.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 15, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 15, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-681, by Ms. Pingree (ME).
- **Dec 15, 2010:** The resolution provides for the consideration of the Senate amendment to H.R. 2965 and makes in order a motion offered by the Majority Leader or his designee that the House concur in the Senate amendment to H.R. 2965 with the amendment printed in the report of the Committee on Rules. The resolution provides one hour of debate on the motion and waives all points of order against consideration of the motion except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI.
- **Dec 15, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 253.
- **Dec 15, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR S8383-8388)
- **Dec 15, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1764.
- **Dec 15, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H8388)
- **Dec 15, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 180 (Roll no. 635).(text: CR H8383)
- **Dec 15, 2010:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 180 (Roll no. 635). (text: CR H8383)
