- **Dec 17, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 17, 2010:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-689, by Mr. Polis (CO).
- **Dec 17, 2010:** All points of order against consideration of the joint resolution are waived except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI.
- **Dec 17, 2010:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 256.
- **Dec 17, 2010:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H8763-8764)
- **Dec 17, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1776.
- **Dec 17, 2010:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H8764)
- **Dec 17, 2010:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1776, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution, and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Sessions demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Dec 17, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H8765-8766)
- **Dec 17, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 184 - 159 (Roll no. 653).(text: CR H8763)
