Summary (as of Jan 6, 2009)

United States Library Trust Fund Act - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to: (1) establish in the Treasury the United States Library Trust Fund (Fund); and (2) allow taxpayers to designate a portion of any tax overpayment (not less than \$1) to the Fund. Authorizes public libraries or public school libraries to receive grants from the Fund.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 16, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Healthy Families and Communities.
- **Jan 6, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 6, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
