111 SRES 80	Related bill	<b>Mar 19, 2009:</b> Submitted in the Senate, considered, and agreed to without amendment and with a preamble by Unanimous Consent. (consideration: CR S3578; text as passed Senate: CR S3578; text of measure as introduced: CR S3575)

Designates the week of March 15-21, 2009, as National Safe Place Week.

Calls on people and groups to promote awareness of, and volunteer involvement in, the Safe Place program (which offers young people in early stages of crisis safe places where trained volunteers are available to counsel and advise them).
