Summary (as of Mar 5, 2009)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow for consideration or disposition of any measure making FY2009 appropriations.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 12, 2009:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 235, H. Res. 218 is laid on the table.
- **Mar 5, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 5, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-24, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Mar 5, 2009:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The waiver is applied to any resolution reported on the legislative day of March 6, 2009, providing for consideration or disposition of any measure making appropriations for the fiscal year 2009, and for other purposes.
- **Mar 5, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 15.
