Summary (as of May 4, 2009)

Recognizes the historical struggle for independence and freedom of the Mexican people and requests the President to issue a proclamation recognizing that struggle and the importance of Cinco de Mayo.

Actions Timeline

- **May 4, 2009:** Mr. Payne moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution, as amended.
- **May 4, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5069-5073)
- **May 4, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 230.
- **May 4, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
- **May 4, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H5081)
