## Summary (as of May 18, 2009)

Taxpayers' Cancer Research Funding Act of 2009- Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow taxpayers to designate on their tax returns a \$5 contribution to the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund (\$10 for joint returns).

Establishes in the Treasury the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund to award grants for breast or prostate cancer research.
