Summary (as of Mar 4, 2010)

Directs the President, pursuant to the War Powers Resolution, to remove the U.S. Armed Forces from Afghanistan: (1) by no later than 30 days after this resolution is adopted; or (2) if the President determines that it is not safe to remove them by such date, by no later than December 31, 2010, or such earlier date that the President determines that they can be safely removed.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 10, 2010:** Rule H. Res. 1146 passed House.
- **Mar 10, 2010:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 1146. (consideration: CR H1251-1286; text of measure as introduced: CR H1251)
- **Mar 10, 2010:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Con. Res. 248 with 3 hours of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Mar 10, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with three hours of debate on H. Con. Res. 248.
