Summary (as of Jul 29, 2010)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary has been expanded because action occurred on the measure.)

Expresses the sense of Congress that: (1) the government of Taiwan should be accorded observer status in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO); (2) the U.S. government should take a leading role in gaining international support for granting Taiwan ICAO observer status; and (3) the Department of State should brief or consult with Congress on U.S. government efforts in support of Taiwan's progress toward ICAO observer status.

- **Jul 29, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR 7/30/2010 H6418)
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR 7/29/2010 H6083)
- **Jul 29, 2010:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR 7/29/2010 H6083)
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 27, 2010:** Ms. Berkley moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
