Summary (as of Jan 6, 2009)

Teacher Tax Reduction Act of 2009 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to increase from \$250 to \$500 the dollar limit on the tax deduction for certain expenses of elementary and secondary school teachers and to extend such deduction through 2011.
