Summary (as of Mar 30, 2009)

Requires the House Committee on Standards of Official Conduct, or a designated investigative subcommittee, to begin immediately an investigation and report to the House on the relationship between: (1) the source and timing of past campaign contributions to Members of the House related to the raided prominent defense-lobbying firm; and (2) earmark requests made by Members on behalf of the firm's clients.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 30, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 30, 2009:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4100-4101; text of measure as introduced: CR H4100)
- **Mar 30, 2009:** QUESTION OF THE PRIVILEGES OF THE HOUSE - Mr. Flake rose to a question of the privileges of the House and offered a resolution. The Chair directed the Clerk to report the resolution. The Clerk completed the reading of H.Res. 295 and the Chair announced that the resolution met the required threshold under the rule.
- **Mar 30, 2009:** Mr. Miller, George moved to table the measure.
