Declares that the compensation and other emoluments attached to the office of the Secretary of the Interior shall be those that were in effect on January 1, 2005.

Sets forth requirements for permitting civil actions and appeals concerning the constitutionality of the appointment and continuance in office of the Secretary of the Interior.
