- **Apr 1, 2009:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 306, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution, and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Ms. Foxx demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption of the resolution until a time to be announced.
- **Apr 1, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H4285)
- **Apr 1, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 236 - 175, 1 Present (Roll no. 177).(text: CR H4262)
- **Apr 1, 2009:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 236 - 175, 1 Present (Roll no. 177). (text: CR H4262)
- **Apr 1, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Mar 31, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 31, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-71, by Mr. Perlmutter.
- **Mar 31, 2009:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the bill.
- **Mar 31, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 38.
