Summary (as of Jul 29, 2010)

Honors the members of the Armed Forces who have served in Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Extends gratitude to U.S. military and civilian personnel responsible for directing the implementation of the "surge strategy" and bringing security and stability to Iraq. Expresses a commitment to working with President Obama and the Administration to build on the military success in Iraq since the surge.

Recognizes: (1) the importance of success in Iraq; and (2) that the President and the Administration have a responsibility to build a lasting strategic partnership between the United States and Iraq.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 16, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Referred to House Armed Services
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs, and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Referred to House Veterans' Affairs
- **Jul 29, 2010:** Referred to House Foreign Affairs
