(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Recognizes: (1) the region from Manhattan, Kansas, to Columbia, Missouri, including the metropolitan Kansas City area and St. Joseph, Missouri, as the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor; and (2) the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor as the national center of the animal health industry.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 15, 2009:** Mr. Holden moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Sep 15, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H9509-9513, H9534-9535)
- **Sep 15, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 317.
- **Sep 15, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Dingell objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
- **Sep 15, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 312 - 108, 1 Present (Roll no. 700).(text: CR H9509-9510)
