Summary (as of Sep 23, 2009)

Santa Cruz Valley National Heritage Area Act - Establishes the Santa Cruz Valley National Heritage Area in Arizona. Requires the Santa Cruz Valley Heritage Alliance, Inc. as the local coordinating entity for the Area, to prepare and submit a management plan for it meeting specified criteria.

Specifies procedures for approval or disapproval of the plan by the Secretary of the Interior in consultation with the Secretary of Homeland Security.

Prohibits anything in this Act from impeding, prohibiting, or restricting activities of the Secretary of Homeland Security for the purpose of achieving operational control, as defined under the Secure Fence Act of 2006, within the Heritage Area.

- **Sep 23, 2009:** Mr. Bishop (UT) moved to recommit with instructions to Natural Resources. (consideration: CR H9851-9853; text: CR H9851)
- **Sep 23, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Bishop (UT) motion to recommit with instructions. The instructions in the motion seek to recommit the same back to the House with an amendment to provide private property owner protection.
- **Sep 23, 2009:** The previous question on the motion to recommit with instructions was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H9852)
- **Sep 23, 2009:** On motion to recommit with instructions Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 259 - 167 (Roll no. 727).
