- **Dec 2, 2010:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Nov 30, 2010:** Mr. Peters moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Nov 30, 2010:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H7728-7730)
- **Nov 30, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 325.
- **Nov 30, 2010:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mrs. Biggert objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
