Summary

(as of Jul 29, 2009)

Bring Assistance to Heroes Act of 2009 - Extends the first-time homebuyer credit (credit) through December 1, 2010, for certain military personnel stationed outside the United States.

Excludes credit-recipient military personnel from: (1) the increased tax credit recapture provision; and (2) accelerated credit recapture regarding disposition of a principal residence if such member receives extended duty orders after the residence's purchase and before the date that such recapture would apply.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 28, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Referred to House Ways and Means
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 29, 2009:** Referred to House Armed Services
