Summary (as of Jul 30, 2009)

North Korea Sanctions Act of 2009 - Imposes certain sanctions under the Arms Export Control Act on North Korea as a result of its May 2009 detonation of a nuclear explosive device.

Authorizes the President to waive such sanctions for reasons of national security or nonproliferation objectives.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 30, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 30, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
