Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2011 - Makes appropriations for FY2011 for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, science-related programs, and related agencies.

Department of Commerce Appropriations Act, 2011 - Makes appropriations for FY2011 for the Department of Commerce for various agencies and programs, including transfers of funds.

Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2011 - Makes appropriations for FY2011 for the Department of Justice (DOJ) for various agencies and programs, including transfers of funds.

Science Appropriations Act, 2011 - Makes appropriations for FY2011 for: (1) the Office of Science and Technology Policy; (2) the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), including for the Office of Inspector General; and (3) the National Science Foundation (NSF), including for the Office of Inspector General.

Makes appropriations for FY2011 for: (1) the Commission on Civil Rights; (2) the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC); (3) the U.S. International Trade Commission (USITC); (4) the Legal Services Corporation; (5) the Marine Mammal Commission; (6) the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR); and (7) the State Justice Institute.

Establishes the Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Latin Americans of Japanese descent.

Specifies certain uses and limits on or prohibitions against the use of funds appropriated by this Act. Rescinds certain unobligated balances of programs funded by this Act.
