Summary (as of Sep 24, 2009)

Makes December 1, 2010, the effective date for applying U.S. immigration laws to the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI).

Directs the Secretary of Homeland Security (DHS) to report to Congress regarding such laws' application to the CNMI.

- **Sep 25, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Insular Affairs, Oceans and Wildlife.

- **Sep 24, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
