- **May 20, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **May 18, 2009:** Mr. Tonko moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **May 18, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5683-5685)
- **May 18, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 374.
- **May 18, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Tonko objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
