Summary (as of Nov 4, 2009)

Preventing All Your Bucks from Aiding non-Citizens is Key Act or PAYBACK Act - Withholds from assistance to a foreign country 110% of the costs incurred by U.S. hospitals and other medical facilities for the long-term care of aliens unlawfully present in the United States from such country until the President certifies to Congress that such costs are fully paid.

Authorizes: (1) a national security waiver of such requirement; and (2) withheld funds to be used for border protection and prevention of illegal immigration.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 4, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border, Maritime, and Global Counterterrorism.
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Referred to House Foreign Affairs
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Referred to House Homeland Security
